Official Ball per sport:

- Baseball: **Rawlings CIF-SS (#R-100)**
Must be this specific ball in playoffs; not alternative Rawlings baseball!
- Boys Basketball: **Spalding TF1000 NFHS (#61-1059)**
Spalding TF1000ZKPro NFHS (#64-4969)
- Girls Basketball: **Spalding TF1000 28.5 NFHS (#61-1079)**
Spalding TF1000ZKPro 28.5 NFHS (#64-4989)
- Football: **Spalding ball with NFHS (J5V #62-8998)**
any model with NFHS authenticating mark
- Soccer: **Spalding TF5000 NFHS** for both boys and girls use. (#64-7928)
- Softball: **Dudley CFP12YFP NFHS.**
- Tennis: **Wilson tennis ball**
- Volleyball: **Spalding with NFHS stamp in these models:**
TF5000 (#62-7918), TF3000 (#62-7938), TF1500 (#72-0601)
- Boys Water Polo: **Mikasa W6000.**
- Girls Water Polo: **Mikasa W6009**

All playoff ball adoptions agreements with the CIF Southern Section run through June 30, 2011.

Mandatory Playoff Use Requirement:

The mandatory “official” ball rule for all playoff rounds, excluding golf. The rule applies throughout the conduct of **all CIF-SS playoff** contests.

Playoff Ball Use Rule Enforcement:

Should a school fail to provide the correct game ball, the game will always be played. Teams/schools failing to utilize the correct official ball in CIF-SS playoffs will be reported by officials to CIF-SS and will not be allowed to host their next available home playoff game. Penalty does carry over to the next season if not enforceable this season due to elimination.
